



Parent Questionnaire 2017/18- Analysis

We have approximately 140 families in the school and 50 questionnaires were returned. One response is approximately 2%. This feedback will be shared with the school Governors to see what can be done to improve on the areas that have been identified as issues. Some responses had a tick placed half-way between the "Agree" and "Disagree" columns, so we have counted those responses as "Neither".

One area that we will look to develop on the basis of the responses below will be online safety which appears not to have been well communicated to parents. All the children are taught about online safety in both discrete lessons and in their curriculum Computing lessons.
