Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to share details of the extra-curricular clubs available for the autumn term 2025.

New this term, we're excited to introduce Basketball Club for children in Year 5 and Year 6 and Cooking Club for those in Year 3 to Year 6. Please refer to the attached list for full details of all clubs, including year group eligibility, the number of sessions offered, and information on costs and how to register. Kindly note that some club year group allocations have changed, so please review the information carefully.

The initial booking stage will open tomorrow, **Thursday 4th September** at 12pm and close on **Friday 5th September** at 12pm. However, if there are spaces, we will re-open the booking stage at 12 noon on **Wednesday 10th September**, allowing parents to go online to sign up for those clubs that are not full. Club bookings will then close for the final time on **Thursday 11th September 2025 at 12pm**. Clubs will officially begin on the week beginning 15th September.

You can sign up for **one club** during the initial booking period. Please do not sign up for more than one club as this will result in all bookings being cancelled.

Important:

Payment for clubs must be made prior to the start date of each club. If payment has not been received, the pupil will not be allowed to join in the activities. Failure to pay may result in them being removed from the club entirely and may still be charged for the placement.

Weather-related cancellations may result in indoor activities with no refunds. It is important to note that if an outdoors club is unable to use the playground due to inclement weather, the club provider will run a classroom-based activity instead. Please note, refunds for clubs altered by the weather will not be available. Refunds cannot be given for clubs if students change their mind or decide not to attend.

In addition, some clubs have set a requirement for a minimum number of participants (see the attached clubs list sheet). If there is not enough interest or bookings in these sessions, the club provider reserves the right to cancel the club and not run it. People who have signed up for a club that does not run due to inadequate numbers will not be charged. Please note that clubs can be cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances and illness. If a club is cancelled, we will endeavour to contact you as soon as possible.

Please note, during the school year there are many activities and school trips. Clubs missed for school residential trips, activities or school outings will not be refunded – parents agree by signing up that they acknowledge this. Please note the INSET day and bank holidays, and check the clubs list to see how many sessions each club is running in the summer term.

CREATE CLUB – TIME TRAVELLERS

WHAT TO EXPECT – WEEKLY SESSION DETAILS:

1. Terrific Time Machines

Children kick off the term by designing and building their own 3D time machine, using colourful card, foam shapes, and fun embellishments. They also plan what they'd pack for their adventure through the ages.

2. Boastful Trajan's Columns

Inspired by Ancient Rome, children create their own version of a Roman triumph column, decorating it with drawings of things they're proud of and sculpting figures in clay to top it off.

3. Loopy Greek Labyrinths

After hearing the myth of Theseus and the Minotaur, children craft a swirling maze with string and card. They then try writing their name using the Greek alphabet!

4. Medieval Illuminated Initials

Children explore medieval manuscripts and decorate their initials on foil with colourful patterns, flowers, vines and mythical creatures, just like scribes of old.

5. Twinkling Tudor Lanterns

Using glass jars (or safe alternatives), tissue paper and silhouette buildings, children make a glowing lantern to light the Tudor streets — complete with a battery tea light.

6. Amazing Aztec Sun Stones

Inspired by ancient Mexican sun stones, children draw and colour symmetrical designs filled with bold shapes and bright colours, learning about Aztec culture along the way.

7. Ancient Pagodas

Children paint a peaceful East Asian landscape, then draw, cut, and decorate their own detailed pagoda to place in their scene — learning about symmetry and balance in architecture.

8. Colourful Celtic Brooches

With swirling spirals and Celtic knots, children use wool and gems to design their own wearable brooches based on real ancient jewellery.

9. Fantastic Fossils

Children draw fossil patterns and create their own clay fossils using shells and dinosaur shapes — then paint and display them just like real paleontologists!

10. World War 2 Toys

Exploring wartime creativity, children use pegs, cardboard, and recycled bits to make toys and games — like dolls, penny spinners, and makeshift vehicles from boxes.

11. A Creative Victorian Christmas

Children go back in time to craft handmade gifts, like a mini wreath for the tree, a decorated placemat, and a painted gift box — in the festive spirit of Victorian Britain.

12. Christmas in 2125

Zooming forward 100 years, kids dream up a sustainable future Christmas — building trees from recycled materials and crafting eco-friendly decorations.

13. Fantastic Future Homes

In this imaginative finale, children design their dream home of the future. Flying beds? Solar domes? Floating gardens? Anything is possible in the year 3000!
