THEME

Theme name: Fire! Fire! Subject Driver: History

In this theme children will learn about the Great Fire of London. In **History** they will be looking at famous historical figures like Guy Fawkes, Samuel Pepys and King Charles II. They will investigate the causes of the Great Fire of London and learn about why the fire spread so guickly. They will learn about what life was like in 1666.
