Rules and Responsibilities

Children will consider the implications of rules and responsibilities for belonging to communities and, in particular, of belonging to a faith community. Children will consider rules in religions and other sources of authority.

This unit contains work on rules, laws and responsibilities in society and in Judaism, Christianity and Islam.

THEME

Theme name: Back To The Future

Subject Driver: Science

In this theme, in **History** the children will be learning about the changes in life in Britain since the 1950s. They will study changes in technology, fashion, music, home and school life, toys and recreation. They will also look at famous people from these decades and study important news events. In **Science**, the children will be studying Evolution and looking at way different species have evolved to adapt to their environments. In **Art**, children will be studying Pop Art and the artist Roy Lichtenstein and they will be creating their own Pop Art paintings. In **Music**, they will continue to develop their understanding of the history of music. In **PHSE**, the children will also be looking ahead to their futures including transition to secondary school and they will be completing the Year 6 Sex and Relationships unit which will include looking at puberty, relationships and human reproduction (including conception and pregnancy).
