## **Sun safe Policy**

I know our weather is very unpredictable but just a few key reminders, taken from our <u>Sun Safe Policy</u>, for consideration during the hot weather:

Parents and carers are advised that it is their responsibility to apply protective creams to their children before the school day begins. Children are not permitted to bring in to school suntan creams/lotions. We would recommend using a 24 hour/long lasting sun cream.

Children are encouraged to bring in a named bottle of water for consumption during the school day. They are reminded to make sure that they are drinking plenty of water during the school day. Children are permitted to refill their water bottles during the day if they run out of water and drinking water is available for all children during lunchtime in the Hall. – All children should have their own named water bottle in school each and every day.

Parents are encouraged to send an appropriate school sun hat, in line with the School's Uniform Policy, into school for their child to wear. Adults in the school are responsible for reminding pupils to wear their hats and all hats should be named to reduce the risk of cross infection of head lice.
