Instrument of Government

1. The name of the school is **Bishop Perrin Church of England School**
2. The school is a **Voluntary Aided** school
3. The governing body shall consist of:
 - a. **Two** elected parent governors
 - b. **One** local education authority governor – nominated by Achieving for Children within the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames
 - c. **Seven** foundation governors
 - d. **One** staff governor
 - e. The Headteacher
4. The total number of governors is **twelve**
5. The bodies entitled to appoint foundation governors are:
 - a. **The Parochial Church Council of St Augustine of Canterbury, Whitton** *[who shall appoint two governors]*
 - b. **The Parochial Church Council of Ss Philip & James, Whitton** *[who shall appoint two governors]*
 - c. **The London Diocesan Board for Schools** *[who shall appoint two governors]*
6. The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex-officio:
the Incumbent of Parish of St Augustine of Canterbury, Whitton

The Archdeacon of Middlesex shall be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in place of the ex-officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named above, in the event that the ex-officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office
7. The Archdeacon of Middlesex shall be entitled to request the removal of the ex-officio foundation governor referred to in 6. And to appoint a substitute governor
8. The school has a trust deed

9. Ethos Statement

Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principals of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church at parish and diocesan levels.

10. The term of office for all governors is four years
