PLEASE ENSURE PAYMENT IS SENT BEFORE THE CLUBS START

Please note the following points:

- Many clubs are led by external companies or providers. As such costs are set by the provider.
- Payment for clubs must be made prior to the start date of each club. If payment has not been received, the pupil will not be allowed to join in the activities. Please be don't put us in the difficult position of not allowing your child to attend a club. Failure to pay may result in them being removed from the club entirely.
- Our wet weather policy for clubs is as follows: sports clubs will either be cancelled or, where practical, classroom-based activities will be put on if the playground/outdoor facilities are unsafe for use.
- Refunds are not available for clubs altered or cancelled due to the weather.
- Refunds are not available for children who are removed from a club due to disruptive or unsafe behaviour.
- Refunds cannot be given for clubs if students change their mind or decide not to attend.
- Refunds cannot be given if a student misses a session due to absence or a school visit/trip.
- Students who are entitled to PPG can choose to get a school run club for free, or a club run by an external provider (EP) for half price.

- Clubs can be cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances and illness.
- Remember, if someone else is picking up your child from the club, please inform the office of this arrangement ahead of time.
- Clubs which do not reach the minimum number of participants will not run.

Club Rules:

- Please behave sensibly and responsibly at all times, upholding the school values and behaviour policy.
- Please commit to your chosen club and attend each session.
- Please arrange to be collected on time.
- Remember to bring suitable clothing/equipment. Including a copy of the book if joining Book Club.
- Not following the school rules can result in you being removed from the club.
