Dear Parents and Carers,

It's that time of year again to book extra-curricular clubs for the summer term 2025. This term, Colouring and Lego Club will be by invitation only. However, we are excited to introduce Create Club for Reception to Year 2- a fun arts and crafts club where children can explore their creativity. Please see the attached list for details on all available clubs and the number of sessions offered.

The initial booking stage will open on **Monday 31<sup>st</sup> March** at 12pm and close on **Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> April** at 12pm. However, if there are spaces, we will re-open the booking stage at 12 noon on **Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> April**, allowing parents to go online to sign up for those clubs that are not full. Club bookings will then close for the final time on **Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2025 at 12pm**. Clubs will officially begin on the week beginning 28<sup>th</sup> April.

You can sign up for **one club** during the initial booking period. Please do not use multiple email addresses to sign up for more than one club as this will result in all bookings being cancelled.

### Important:

Payment for clubs must be made prior to the start date of each club. If payment has not been received, the pupil will not be allowed to join in the activities. Failure to pay may result in them being removed from the club entirely and may still be charged for the placement.

Please note that clubs missed due to school trips or activities will not be refunded. Also, weather-related cancellations may result in indoor activities, with no refunds for weather-related changes. It is important to note that if an outdoors club is unable to use the playground due to inclement weather, the club provider will run a classroom-based activity instead. Please note, refunds for clubs altered by the weather will not be available. Refunds cannot be given for clubs if students change their mind or decide not to attend.

In addition, some clubs have set a requirement for a minimum number of participants (see the attached clubs list sheet). If there is not enough interest or bookings in these sessions, the club provider reserves the right to cancel the club and not run it. People who have signed up for a club that does not run due to inadequate numbers will not be charged. Please note that clubs can be cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances and illness. If a club is cancelled, we will endeavour to contact you as soon as possible.

Please note, during the summer term there are many activities and trips. Clubs missed for school residential trips, activities or school outings will not be refunded – parents agree by signing up that they acknowledge this. Please note the INSET day and bank holidays, and check the clubs list to see how many sessions each club is running in the summer term.

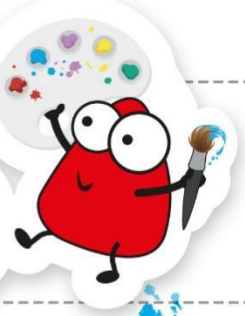

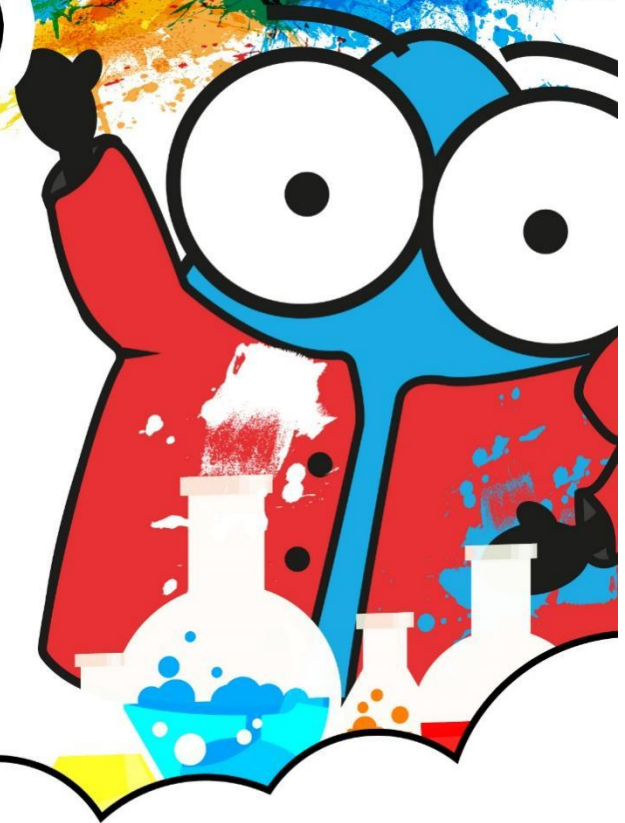

## Week 3: Mexican Animalitos

## Week 4: Indian Mandalas

A creative session celebrating **Japanese traditions**, as children paint cherry blossom trees and learn simple origami techniques to create delicate paper crafts.

## Week 7: Marvellous Mayan Masks

Travel to **South America** and design a Mayan-inspired **mosaic mask** using bold colours and geometric patterns.

## Week 8: The Arctic & Its Changing Environment

A lesson in **climate awareness** as children create an icy **scrape-art Arctic landscape**, adding polar animals and a message about protecting our planet.

## Week 9: Native American Pottery & Weaving

Exploring the crafts of **Native American tribes**, children will create their own clay **pinch pots** and learn simple basket weaving techniques.

## Week 10: Turkish Ebru Art

Discover the mesmerising world of **marbling** with this traditional Turkish technique, creating stunning swirling patterns on paper.
