The children will learn about the importance of prayer to Christians, and in particular, The Lord's Prayer.

THEME

Theme name: It's a Small World Subject Driver: Geography

In **geography** children will be learning about the continents and oceans of the world. They will learn about some of the physical and human features of different the different continents. They will learn how to use a map to find different countries and will use atlases and globes. In **music**, children will develop their listening skills and evaluate different pieces of music.
