English

Key Text: Children of the Benin Kingdom (ISBN 978-1999336332)

Writing: Children will be writing a story with an issue or a dilemma, they will also be writing a non-fiction recount.

Reading: Children will be reading a variety of narrative stories set in Africa.

Spoken Word: Children will listen to and practise reading aloud a variety of poetry.

Text and Word: Children will learn how to use the verb prefixes: dis-, de-, mis-, over- and re-

Punctuation: Children will learn how to use a colon to introduce a quote. They will also learn how to use inverted commas to show a quotation or the title of a book or film.

Sentence structure: Children will learn how to indicate degrees of possibility using modal verbs – might, should, will, must or adverbs e.g. perhaps, surely.

Theme

Theme name: Amazing Africa

In **DT**, children will be researching and learning how to cook African inspired recipes. In **science**, children will be learning about the life cycles of amphibians, birds, insects and mammals. They will learn about reproduction in plants and some animals as well as learning about how humans change as they age. In **history**, children will be learning about the Kingdom of Benin using a range of different sources, including Benin bronzes. They will look at the similarities and differences between life in Benin and Britain at the time and will understand why the Kingdom of Benin came to an end. In **music**, children will have a go at African drumming. In **PSHE**, children will learn about what positively and negatively affects health. They will find out about habits and the effects of legal and illegal substances.
