INVITATION TO YR & Y1 PARENTS

As we continue to implement our new phonics programme, Little Wandle Letters and Sounds Revised, we would like to take the opportunity to invite parents of children in Year R and Year 1 to visit a phonics session in their child's class during the school day.

This will provide an opportunity to see how a phonics session is delivered; how the children learn and apply their phonics as they begin to learn to read, and it will help to support links with the reading practise books the children access at home.

We would strongly encourage all parents of Year R and Year 1 children to attend one of these sessions, as they will provide a valuable insight into how your child is beginning to learn to read and spell.

We will run these open phonics sessions throughout the spring term. This half term they will be available on Tuesday mornings, and next half term on Thursday mornings. We can allow a maximum of three parents (one adult per family) to attend any one session. One session per term, per family, may be booked, to ensure enough availability of sessions for everyone.

Please book your session by calling or visiting the school office.

Year R phonics sessions will be on Tuesday (spring 1) / Thursday (spring 2) morning, 9.00 – 9.20
Year 1 phonics sessions will be on Tuesday (spring 1) / Thursday (spring 2) morning, 10.45 – 11.00

Please note we are unable to offer any alternative days to attend sessions.

These opportunities are for observation only, and will not require parents to get involved in any activities with the children. At the end of the session, the class teacher will be able to give you a brief summary and explanation of what you have seen, but please be aware this will not be an opportunity to discuss your individual child's phonics progress. There will be an opportunity to discuss their progress at the upcoming parent interviews towards the end of this month. However, you will now find a copy of your child's latest phonics assessment (completed in December) in the back of their reading log, so you can keep track of how they are doing.
