There will be no Football Club on Wednesday 25th Jan for Yrs 5 and 6 due to Parent Interviews happening that day.

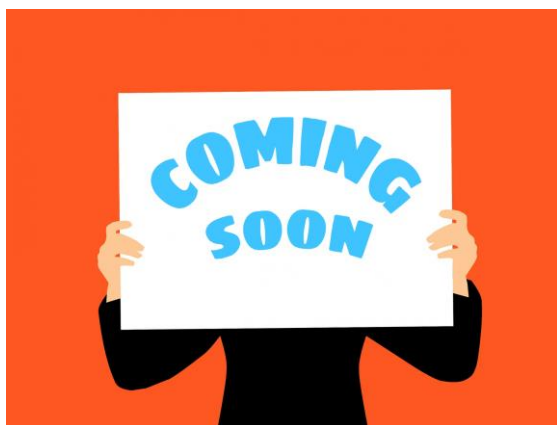
RECEPTION APPLICATIONS 2023
