Breakfast Club Vacancy

We have a vacancy, as of 1st September, for a Breakfast Club Manager at Bishop Perrin School. The job is during term time only and the the hours are 7.30-8.45am Monday to Friday, which allows for setting up and clearing away, with an additional hour paid for food ordering and admin (7.25 hours per week in total). The post is paid on the NJC Grade 4, Spinal Point 9 (equivalent to £14.10 per hour). Breakfast Club staff will be allowed to bring their primary-aged children to Breakfast Club for free. This means that all children in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 need to wear black shorts and plain black track suit bottoms. Leggings, either long or short, are not part of the Uniform Policy, so please make sure your child has the correct kit. Children not wearing the correct kit will be spoken to and contact made with parents. It is unfair on other children who are wearing the correct kit when they see children wearing non-compliant kit. A lot of children are coming in to school, outside of mufti days, wearing wrist bands and bracelets that are not linked to their religion. Please ensure your child is not wearing something around their wrist when coming to school or it will be taken off them.
