RECEPTION AND YEAR 6 CHILDREN HEIGHT AND WEIGHT CHECKS

On Thursday 14th October the School Health Service will be in school to measure children in Reception Class and Year 5. If you have not already done so please give consent for your child to take part via the Parent Portal (details below).

Introducing the Parent Portal (School Screener)

School Health Services will be using a new electronic way of communicating with parents and carers through a secure web-based portal. Parents and carers of children in <u>Reception and Year 6</u> are being asked to register on the portal to receive information and register on the 2021-2022 NCMP (National Child Measurement Programme) and to opt out should you wish to, using the following link:

It's a really quick process and all you need is an email address which you have access to. Once registered you can login and add your child/ren's details. Once the measurement has taken place you will be able to log back into the portal to view your child's result letter. The parent portal is GDPR compliant, so both parent and child's personal data is safer too.

FREE BLOOD PRESSURE CHECK

May Measurement Month (MMM), the global campaign run by the International Society of Hypertension (ISH) to raise awareness of the need for people to get their blood pressure (BP) checked, kicked off in May 2021 with increased energy, asking people to 'roll their sleeves up' and take action. 10.8 million people die annually of blood pressure related conditions, many of which were completely undetected. A simple oneminute test could prevent this.

The MMM team have offered their free BP screening services to Bishop Perrin parents, teachers and staff. The team will be at school on the following dates and will be providing free blood pressure screenings and advice:

Friday 15th October 08:40 - 09:30

Friday 5th November 14:30 - 16:00

Screenings are carried out on a first come, first served basis and will be held in the school courtyard (just outside the Main Reception). Each BP screening takes approximately 5mins to carry out.
