FLU VACCINE – SIGN UP REMINDER

The School Nurse Team will be visiting on Wednesday 16th to administer the Flu Nasal Spray.

It is important that only one consent form is submitted per child. If you need to make any changes to your consent form, please contact the Immunisation team rather than submit a second consent.
